What is a rollator? A rollator differs from a traditional walker in that it has wheels at the bottom of each leg, a handlebar and often a built-in seat. Rollators are better for navigating uneven surfaces, have a sturdy frame and many optional accessories that can make it easy to carry and transport everyday items.

Participants will engage in exciting group activities, then build and decorate their rollators.
